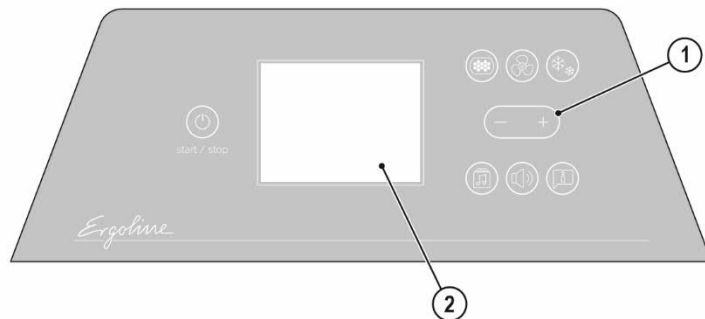

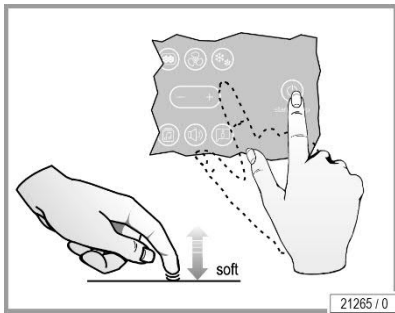

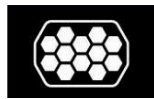
## 1.2.1 Navigation

## 2 Setup Manager



In SETUP MANAGER, operating states can be called up and pre-settings entered.

### 2.1 General notes




NOTE:

Pre-setting mode can only be called up when tanning is not taking place.

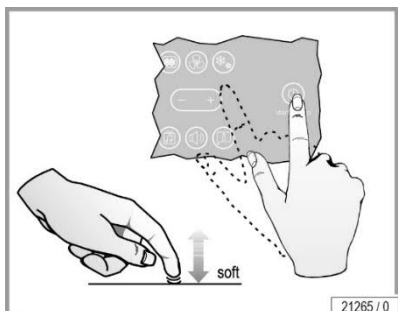
30 seconds after the last button was pressed, the device changes automatically into standby mode.

#### 2.1.1 Open the SETUP MANAGER (pre-setting mode)

- To open the SETUP MANAGER press the  button for approx. 3 seconds.

In the delivery state, you can access the pre-settings using the master code.

- Enter the master code (default setting 1000).

## 2.1.2 Master code

The master code allows you to access all of the pre-settings.

If you know the current master code, you can specify a new code at any time.

If you have forgotten the code, please contact customer service.



Code upon delivery (factory default)





Master code: 1000



### NOTE:

We recommend that you set a new master code when starting up the device for the first time in order to prevent unauthorized access to the pre-setting mode. Please make a note of the code for customer service.



Changing the code



- Press the button  for 3 seconds.
- Enter the current master code.
- Press the button  until  appears.
- Press the button  to select the master code.

Change the master code



Use the  /  buttons to select the digits.

Change the current digits using  or .

Once you have set up the required code, press the  button to save it.

- Press and hold the  button for approx. 3 seconds to exit the 'Master code' window.





### NOTE:


Example '1000': Press  3 times and  once.


Example '0001': Press  0 times and  once.

If the master code is entered correctly, the system will switch straight to the SETUP MANAGER menu.














### 2.1.3 View and change the pre-settings

Use the  /  buttons to access the previous or next function. When selecting multiple digits, the system switches between the digits.



In all cases, the selection must be confirmed with .

Use  to reset the individual operating hours (press for approx. 3 seconds until you hear the confirmation signal).

	<p>Change the values:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Use  to select the change function.</li> <li>- Change the current value using  or .</li> <li>- For multiple digits, switch between positions with .</li> <li>- Use  to save the function change.</li> </ul>
	<p>Change the selection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Use  to select the change function.</li> <li>- Change the current status using  or . <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Function active: </li> <li>➤ Function not active: </li> </ul> </li> <li>- Use  to save the function change.</li> </ul>

	Settings for the user: Cleaning confirmation, emergency shut-down time, selection of the functions displayed on the user menu.
	<p>Activate or deactivate the cleaning confirmation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Function active: <input checked="" type="checkbox"/></li> <li>➤ Function not active: <input type="checkbox"/></li> </ul>
	<p>Emergency shut-down time in minutes, max. 33 min. Change the emergency shut-down time: (Time: 5–33 minutes)</p> <p><b>i</b> NOTE: If the user attempts to set the value higher than 33 minutes, the max. emergency shut-down time of 33 minutes will be used. Once you have set up the required emergency shut-down time, press the  button to save it.</p>







	<p>Selection of a pre-defined color program: Color programs 1–8</p>
	<p>Change the accent lighting runtime (min.): Permanent or time in minutes (0–1441 minutes, 0 = off)</p> <p><b>i</b> NOTE: The lighting is switched on permanently when 1441 minutes is selected.</p>





	Remaining operating hours for the filters in the canopy and base. Resetting the remaining filter operating hours: Press the  button until you hear the confirmation signal (approx. 3 seconds).
	Operating hours of the air conditioning and the filter in the air conditioning. Resetting the remaining filter operating hours: Press the  button until you hear the confirmation signal (approx. 3 seconds).
